The Brief Intervention Program provides a forum for youth to gain accurate information about substance use while empowering them to set attainable goals to make healthy choices. This short-term prevention service consists of 3, 30–60-minute sessions on school campus working one-on-one with a CCOE Prevention Services Personnel.

BRIEF INTERVENTION IS DESIGNED FOR STUDENTS WHO:

- May have violated Education Code due to possession of substances on campus.
- Are experiencing issues at school or home associated with tobacco/vaping.
- Staff is concerned about due to seeing telltale signs in youth

ADDITIONAL BENEFITS OF BRIEF INTERVENTION:

- Awarded a certificate upon program completion.
- Established plan tailored to meet the needs of adolescents.
- Work closely with a Prevention Services personnel who will utilize cognitive behavioral therapy, motivational interviewing, and the stages of change model with each adolescent.
