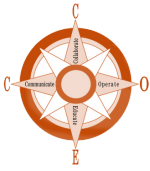

## “BASH FOR BEV” DONATION SUPPORTS COLUSA COUNTY SPECIAL EDUCATION STUDENTS

In late October, CCOE’s Deputy Superintendent of Student Services, Chuck Wayman, received a donation for the Special Education Department from Jason English in memory of Beverly Armocido. English is the organizer and producer of the annual “Bash for Bev” event, where all proceeds are donated to schools and educational programs within Colusa County.

Started in August 2019, “Bash for Bev” was inspired by Armocido, who lost her battle with cancer earlier that January. English wanted to honor her death by planning this community event and making a monetary donation with its proceeds to assist students in Colusa County. Comprised of live music, a car show, dinner and dessert, the “Bash for Bev” event has continued to pull in more and more people each year. As a result, Jason English is able to continue making impactful donations in Bev Armocido’s name, and CCOE is grateful to English for the opportunity to directly and positively impact Colusa County’s Special Education students.

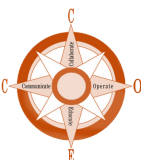

## STUDENT BOOKS ON DISPLAY

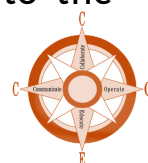

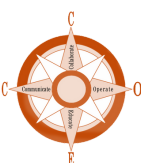
## MEET & GREET EVENT HELD IN WILLIAMS
